Notes for Authors Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan

Papers and Editorial Policy

Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan publishes original research on all aspects of the science and technology of adhesion. Papers appearing in Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan comprise Original Paper, Technical Report, Note, Short Communication, Comprehensive Paper, Review, Commentary, Introductory Article – Doctor Thesis, Topics, Report, Introductory Article – Laboratory, and the others. Note and Short Communication should be preferably less than 2 printed pages. Papers already published or scheduled to be published elsewhere will not be accepted.

Submission

Manuscripts should be submitted to Editor-in-Chief, Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan as email attachments. The corresponding author's mailing address, phone number, fax number, and email address should be included. If electric data are unavailable, send one original and one copy of the manuscript to Editor-in-Chief, Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan.

Manuscripts

Manuscripts must be original and have not been published before and are not currently being considered for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts must be written in English. Manuscripts should be written using A4 sized paper with 25 mm margins on all four edges of the paper. The pages must be numbered consecutively. Abstract and about five keywords should be placed between the title of the paper including authors' names, affiliations, and addresses and the text. Abstract should be written as concisely as possible, preferably in less than 200 words. The text must be divided into the following sections: Introduction, Experimental or Theoretical, Results, Discussion and Conclusions. Results and Discussion sections may be combined, if desired.

References to the literature should be numbered in one consecutive series. The following format must be followed.

Reviewing and Revision

All manuscripts submitted to Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan are reviewed prior to publication. The editors may ask that a manuscript be revised. If the revised paper is not submitted within two months, and the reason for the delay is not acceptable, or not given, the manuscript may be regarded as having been withdrawn. The revised manuscript must be accompanied by the original manuscript and also must be accompanied by a covering letter of response to each of the comments of the reviewers and a list of changes made in the original.

Copyright

The copyright of every paper published in Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan shall be transferred to The Adhesion Society of Japan. All contributors are requested to send manuscripts with the "Copyright Transfer Form", which is downloadable at our website.

Only the first galley proofs are sent to the author. The author can correct typographical errors only. Reprints can be ordered at the time when the galley proofs are returned to the Editorial Office, Journal of The Adhesion Society of Japan.

Page Charge

No page charge is requested to the authors. The production cost for color pages is separately charged.
